Required of All Students for Unqualified Admission:

1. Apply for admission through the Graduate College in 202 Whitehurst (405.744.6371). For information pertinent to the application process, for forms, and/or online admission, access <http://gradcollege.okstate.edu>.
2. Grade point average >3.00 in a Bachelors degree from an accredited institution.
3. Miller Analogies Test scaled score of >390 OR a Graduate Record Exam score of >950 (with preferred minimums of 500 verbal and 450 quantitative).
4. Three letters of recommendation providing information related to past academic ability, potential for graduate study, and writing ability.
5. Availability of academic advisor.

Provisional Admission:

1. Admission on a provisional basis may be possible if either #2 or #3 above is not met.
2. Students admitted on a provisional basis should not take more than nine credit hours during the first semester.
3. Students admitted on a provisional basis will be reviewed for full admission by Educational Technology faculty prior to enrollment in the second semester.
