DEADLY MEDICINE: CREATING THE MASTER RACE

COST: \$33

This is a traveling exhibit from the United States HOLOCAUST MEMORIAL MUSEUM. It will be presented in only three cities in the United States at this time, New York City, Oklahoma City, and San Francisco.

From 1933 to 1945, Nazi Germany carried out a campaign to “cleanse” German society of individuals viewed as biological threats to the nation’s “health.” Enlisting the help of physicians and medically trained geneticists, psychiatrists, and anthropologists, the Nazis implemented racial health policies based on the ideals of eugenics that began with the mass sterilization of “genetically diseased” persons and ended with the near annihilation of European Jews, ultimately killing six million in the Holocaust.

The SCIENCE MUSEUM OF OKLAHOMA also houses the INTERNATIONAL GYMNASTICS HALL OF FAME with its Library of gymnastics history w/extensive video collection, memorabilia, and watercolor portraits of inductees.

The Omniplex Science exhibits featuring over 350 hands-on exhibits that let a person explore the wonder and relevance of science in everyday life is also still available.
