WHAT THE GUIDE IS

This is a guide to scholarships awarded by Oklahoma State University to students attending the Stillwater campus. While every effort was made to make it complete and accurate, this first printed, comprehensive, university-wide listing should be considered a work in progress.

Unless otherwise directed, entering freshmen and transfer students must complete OSU's scholarship application (found in the "Applying to OSU" booklet) to receive priority consideration for the State Regents' Academic Scholars Program, the President's Distinguished Scholarship (PDS), the President's Leadership Council (PLC) Scholarship, the Valedictorian Scholarship, and other scholarships, including those offered by OSU's colleges and departments and by the OSU Alumni Association and its chapters.

By completing one scholarship application, an incoming freshman or transfer student will be considered for all of the scholarships for which he or she is eligible. However, scholarships are awarded from many offices on campus, not from a single location. For that reason, inquiries about a specific scholarship should be directed to the appropriate contact person or office listed for that scholarship.

This publication contains both undergraduate and graduate scholarships and includes a brief description of the eligibility criteria for each. As a student may hold some scholarships for several years (provided he/she meets the renewal criteria), those scholarships may not become available again until the current recipient graduates. Other scholarships are awarded only when funding is available.

Unless otherwise specified, students with renewable scholarships must achieve a **3.00 cumulative graduation/retention GPA** or higher *and* complete at least **28 credit hours** each academic year to renew the scholarship. Compliance with both standards is checked at the end of the spring semester. *Always check with the appropriate office to ensure that you understand any scholarship's renewal criteria.* Scholarship renewals are contingent upon availability of funding.

Oklahoma State University encourages all students to complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) as soon after January 1 as possible (earlier is better). *Some need-based scholarships require students to complete the FAFSA.* The FAFSA is available from high school counselors and from the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid after January 1 each year. USING THE INDEX

This index lists all scholarships alphabetically under the appropriate college, department, or office.

PRIORITY DATES

To receive priority consideration for *entering freshman and transfer student scholarships*, the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid must RECEIVE the application by 5 p.m. on February 1. Some college and departmental scholarships may have earlier or later deadlines (see those sections for details). Students applying after the priority deadline may still be considered, but applications received by February 1 will receive first consideration.

To receive priority consideration for *continuing student scholarships* available to currently enrolled, full-time students already attending OSU, the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid must RECEIVE the application by 5 p.m. on March 1. Some college and departmental scholarships may have earlier or later deadlines (see those sections for details).

ESSAYS, STATEMENTS, AND OTHER ATTACHMENTS

Some scholarships require essays, need statements, letter(s) of recommendation, etc. Attach those items only if instructed to do so.

Graduate students apply using the CASNR Graduate Student application due by 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January.

Incoming freshman students apply by completing the OSU Scholarship application in the OSU Admission Application packet. Application is due February 1.

AGRICULTURAL CENTENNIAL GRADUATES SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$1,000 scholarships are available to incoming freshmen students enrolled full-time in CASNR who demonstrate high academic achievement and leadership.

DEADLINE: February 1.

A. E. DARLOW MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A \$500 scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding graduate student enrolled in Animal science. The student is selected by the Department of Animal science and is recognized at the CASNR Scholarship and Awards Banquet in March.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

AGRICULTURAL LEGISLATIVE INTERNSHIP

This \$3100 award is to be used in the Spring semester only and is available to students in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources who have completed at least one year and have at least one year of college remaining after the completion of the Agricultural Legislative Internship.

DEADLINE: November 1.

ALVIN AND SUSIETTA BERG SCHOLARSHIP

This \$2500 scholarship is available to junior or senior students with a minimum 3.25 GPA enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. The recipient must have aptitude for scientific research. The scholarship is renewable for two years, only one of which may be as a graduate student.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

BANCFIRST SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is available to students who are studying Agriculture Business with an interest in banking and finance and whose homes are in North Central Oklahoma. Financial need is considered.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

BEN AND ALMA GRANT ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500-\$750 scholarship is available to freshmen students enrolled full-time in animal science or biosystems and agricultural engineering who have a minimum 3.25 GPA. Financial need is a consideration and the recipient may not have a substantial investment portfolio.

DEADLINE: February 1.

CASNR ANONYMOUS ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

These scholarships are awarded to full-time student(s) enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. The recipient(s) must have participated in 4-H or FFA, with first preference given to students from Payne County. Recipient(s) must demonstrate financial need.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

CHRIS & LYDIA WHITE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$750 scholarships are available each year to incoming freshmen pursuing studies in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Recipients must have been members of FFA in high school.

DEADLINE: February 1.

DEAN PAUL HUMMER SCHOLARSHIP

The student receiving this \$500 scholarship must be a continuing student enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. They should demonstrate high academic achievement and leadership.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

DORSE B. AND LOTA GILL JEFFREY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Two recipients will be selected. Selection of recipients in the Division of Agriculture will be made by the Department of Agricultural Economics Scholarship Committee. Division of Agriculture scholarship recipients must be a graduate of an Oklahoma high school and entering their junior year of study at OSU with a major in agricultural economics. Preference shall be given to students from Murray, Carter, Love, Marshal, or Johnston counties. Transfer students are eligible for this award. Selection is based on character, leadership and need for financial assistance. A 2.5 or higher grade point average must be maintained. Transfer students are eligible for this award. Selection is based on character, leadership and need for financial assistance. Recipient must maintain a 2.5 or higher grade point average.

DOW AGROSCIENCES AGRICULTURE CHEMICAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$750 scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding sophomore, junior or senior majoring in agriculture with an interest in chemical fields. A minimum 3.25 GPA is required.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

DR. MIKE STANTON SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is available to a student who has graduated from Ringling High School. Awards are made in order of preference: 1) entering freshman, 2) sophomore, 3) junior or 4) senior.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

EUGENE H. FRANZ ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

A \$500-\$750 scholarship is available for sophomores, juniors or seniors enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Applicants should have demonstrated potential for success to be qualified. Financial need is considered and a minimum 3.25 GPA is required.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

FFA STATE OFFICER SCHOLARSHIP

Any FFA State Officer enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources is awarded a minimum \$1,000 scholarship during their freshman year.

DEADLINE: This is an automatic award and does not require an application.

FLEMING CONTINUING STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$750 scholarships are available to sophomores, juniors and seniors enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. A minimum 3.25 GPA and leadership qualities are required.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

FLEMING TRANSFER STUDENT SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$750 scholarships are available to full-time transfer students who are entering OSU for the first time. Previous recipients are ineligible.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

4-H STATE OFFICER SCHOLARSHIPS

Any 4-H State Officer enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources is awarded a minimum \$1,000 scholarship during their freshman year.

DEADLINE: This is an automatic award and does not require an application.

FRED LECRONE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A \$500 scholarship is awarded to a sophomore, junior, or senior enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources who demonstrates leadership and academic excellence with a minimum 3.25 GPA.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

GRACE MCKINZIE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$750 scholarship is available to incoming freshmen or continuing students enrolled in a field of study in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Applicants should demonstrate financial need.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

HAROLD AND JUANITA SWIGERT SCHOLARSHIPS

Students enrolled full-time in an environmental science major in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources who are Native American are eligible to apply for these \$2,000 scholarships.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

JERRY GRANT MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship is available to graduate students enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources in the majors of plant and soil sciences or animal science. A minimum 3.25 GPA is required and financial need is considered. The recipient must be an international student who has an interest in returning to his/her country or another agriculturally developing nation. They must have the potential to make a positive impact and contribution to the agricultural sector of that country or nation.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

JIM HOUGH CENTENNIAL SCHOLARSHIP - AGRICULTURE

This \$1,000-\$1250 scholarship is available to incoming freshmen enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources in the major of animal science, agricultural education, agricultural economics, or pre-veterinary medicine. A minimum 3.25 GPA and evidence of financial need are required. The scholarship is renewable for three additional years with renewed application and the recipient continues to meet the scholarship criteria.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

JOE ALEXANDER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$750 scholarships are awarded to incoming freshmen from eastern Oklahoma. Selection is based on overall excellence and the scholarship is renewable for one year as a continuing sophomore.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

JOHN D. FELLERS AND KAREN HOWELL SCHOLARSHIP IN PLANT AND SOIL SCIENCES

A \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to a full-time sophomore, junior or senior enrolled in plant sciences or another agronomy major. The student must exemplify a strong ambition and true initiative in the pursuit of a degree and have a high grade point average. This scholarship is renewable.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

JOSEPH FLEMING FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP

\$1,000 scholarships are available to entering freshmen enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Selection is based on leadership, academic excellence and financial need.

DEADLINE: February 1.

JOSEPH FLEMING CONTINUING AND TRANSFER SCHOLARSHIPS

Scholarships in the amount of \$750 are available to continuing and transfer students enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Selection is based on leadership, academic excellence and financial need.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

JOSEPH R. PAYNE, JR. MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Scholarships in the amount of \$2,000 per year for up to four years are awarded to juniors or seniors whose homes are in Stephens County, OK. The student must maintain a 2.75 GPA to be eligible for renewal.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

LONG BROTHERS FFA SCHOLARSHIP

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding high school senior who enrolls full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources and who is active in the FFA. The student must be a county resident of Kay, Noble, Logan, Garfield, Grant, Kingfisher, Alfalfa, or Majors County. A minimum GPA of 3.25 and an essay are required. Long Brothers FFA applications are available through the FFA Vocational Agricultural teachers in the high schools in the applicable counties or from the Academic Programs Office, College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources.

DEADLINE: February 1.

LONG BROTHERS 4-H SCHOLARSHIP

A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded to an outstanding high school senior who is to be enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources and who is active in the 4-H. The student must be a county resident of Kay, Noble, Logan, Garfield, Grant, Kingfisher, Alfalfa, or Majors County. A minimum GPA of 3.25 and an essay are required. Long Brothers 4-H applications are available through the County Extension Agents in the applicable counties or from the Academic Programs Office, College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources.

DEADLINE: February 1.

MARVIN KLEMME AGRICULTURE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

These \$2,000 scholarships are awarded to full-time students coming from counties in Oklahoma served by the Marvin Klemme Range Research Station and who are enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. These scholarships are renewable with a new application each year pending the student continues to meet the criteria.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

MCALESTER SCOTTISH RITE FELLOWSHIP

Two \$500 scholarships are available to graduate students enrolled in the pursuit of a graduate degree in a field of study in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources.

DEADLINE: February 1.

NATIONAL MERIT SCHOLARSHIP IN AGRICULTURE

Two of these scholarships will be awarded to incoming freshmen enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources who are National Merit Finalists.

DEADLINE: None.

NOBLE FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

These \$1,000 scholarships are available to juniors and seniors enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Applicants must have a minimum 3.25 GPA.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

OKLAHOMA COUNTY ASSOCIATION FOR FAMILY AND COMMUNITY EDUCATION

This \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded bi-annually to a sophomore enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Academic achievement and financial aid are considered.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

OKLAHOMA FARM BUREAU

This \$500-\$750 scholarship will be awarded to an incoming freshman exhibiting leadership and academic excellence. Applicants must be enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources, and financial need is also considered.

DEADLINE: February 1.

OKLAHOMA FERTILIZER AND CHEMICAL ASSOCIATION

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to a junior or senior majoring in agriculture with an interest in Agronomy or Entomology (fertilizer or agricultural chemicals). A minimum 3.25 GPA is required.

Applications are available through the Oklahoma Fertilizer and Chemical Association, 2309 N. 10th, Suite E, Enid, OK 73701.

DEADLINE: February 1.

OKLAHOMA FERTILIZER AND CHEMICAL ASSOCIATION

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to freshman, sophomore, junior or senior students in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Applicants must have a family member employed by Oklahoma Fertilizer & Chemical Association or a family member who does business with OFCA. A minimum 3.2 GPA is required. Applications are due February 1 and are available through the Oklahoma Fertilizer & Chemical Association, 2309 N. 10th, Suite E., Enid, OK 73701.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

OLEN D. AND CLARA JOYNER SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to incoming freshmen students from Mountain View-Gotebo, OK. The student must be enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources in animal science, animal science/agricultural education teaching double major, agricultural education/teaching option, agricultural education/agricultural economics double major or agricultural education/horticulture double major.

DEADLINE: February 1.

ORSCHLON FARM AND HOME SUPPLY SCHOLARSHIPS

Three \$1,000 scholarships are available to freshmen whose homes are in Carter, Stephens, Pontotoc, or an adjacent county who are enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. Applicants should exhibit a commitment to agriculture and the family farm perpetuation and demonstrate leadership and academic achievement. Students should also have a background in FFA.

DEADLINE: February 1.

PAUL D. HUMMER SCHOLARSHIP

A \$500 scholarship is available to a continuing student enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources who has demonstrated high academic achievement and leadership.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

PAUL E. AND BONNIE MAE HARRILL SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship of at least \$500-\$650 is available to sophomores, juniors, or seniors enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. A minimum 3.25 GPA and financial need are required. The scholarship is renewable with a new application submitted the following year.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

RANDALL J. JONES MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1000 scholarship is available to sophomores, juniors, and seniors who are enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources and who have exemplified leadership and academic excellence.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

ROBERT E. SMITH MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500-\$600 scholarship is available to a freshman enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Science and Natural Resources who has an interest in soil conservation. A minimum 3.25 GPA is required.

DEADLINE: February 1.

ROBERT L. BORDEN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

A \$500-\$700 scholarship is available. Preference is given to a student enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources and who is a graduate of LeFlore High School, a resident of LeFlore County, or whose home is in Latimer County. The scholarship is renewable upon application and continuation of the criteria.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

R. T. KIRKPATRICK SCHOLARSHIP

A \$500-\$750 scholarship is available to an undergraduate student showing excellence in academic achievement and leadership who is enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. A minimum 3.25 GPA is required with a preference to applicants with financial need.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

TRIANGLE COOPERATIVE SERVICE COMPANY SCHOLARSHIPS

Two \$1000 scholarships are awarded to juniors or seniors with an Ag. Coop background. Preference given to students whose family member is employed by or is an active member of a cooperative.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

WILLIAM H. KOSANKE CENTENNIAL SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1,250 scholarship is available to a freshman enrolled full-time in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. The applicant's family must be active in an Oklahoma Co-op and the applicant must have an interest in the production or agri-business area of the cotton industry. A minimum 3.25 GPA is required.

DEADLINE: February 1.

WILLIAM HARVEY PASLEY AND MAUDE FROST PASLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Several \$1,000 scholarships are available to incoming freshmen enrolled in the College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources. These scholarships are renewable for three additional years if the student maintains a 2.5 GPA and remains in good academic standing. Incoming freshmen apply by completing the OSU Freshman Application.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

WILLIAMS OUTSTANDING THESIS AWARDS

Three \$1,000 awards are provided to graduate students nominated by their home department as having submitted the best thesis in one of three areas: 1) plant sciences, 2) animal sciences, and 3) social sciences/engineering sciences.

DEADLINE: Award winners are selected by a College of Agricultural Sciences and Natural Resources Committee and are announced at the College Scholarships and Awards Banquet in March.

Variable amount scholarships are given to outstanding incoming or continuing agricultural economics/agribusiness students who may not qualify for other scholarships, or as a supplement to scholarships already received.

DEADLINE: Freshman - February 1. Continuing/Transfer - 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

AGRICULTURAL ECONOMICS PRE-LAW SCHOLARSHIP

This \$500 scholarship is awarded to an outstanding agricultural economics/agribusiness junior or senior student who plans to attend law school. Agricultural economics alumni who are practicing attorneys fund the scholarship.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

BANK OF OKLAHOMA ALUMNI SCHOLARSHIP

A total of \$1,500 is awarded to one or more full-time student(s) majoring in agricultural economics or agribusiness who have demonstrated both academic and leadership excellence. Funds are provided by alumni working for Bank of Oklahoma.

DEADLINE: 5:00PM on Friday of the third week of January

BANCFIRST OF STILLWATER SCHOLARSHIP

This \$750 scholarship is awarded to an agricultural economics/agribusiness major who is a junior or senior and is interested in agricultural finance and is from the bank's trade area.

DEADLINE: 5:00pm on Friday of the third week of January

BETTY JO AND DANIEL D. BADGER SCHOLARSHIP

This \$1,000 scholarship is awarded to an agricultural economics/agribusiness student who has demonstrated academic excellence and leadership ability. The scholarship is funded by family and friends of Betty Jo and Daniel Badger.

BILL PATRICK SCHOLARSHIP
