



2008-2009 Estimated Educational Expenses

*Figures represent the best estimate at the time (July, 2008)
and are subject to change without notice.*

The following budgets are **estimates** of educational expenses for the academic year beginning August 2008 and ending May 2009 (3rd year Veterinary Medicine costs are based on a 12-month academic year). Costs include tuition and fees, room and board (on-campus or off-campus), books and supplies, transportation and miscellaneous personal expenses. **Because cost budgets include many categories, you may spend more or less than the budget estimates.**

To be considered as part of enrolled hours for purposes of financial aid, courses must be applicable to your degree. These budgets are used to determine eligibility for undergraduates enrolled in at least six (6) hours per semester and graduates enrolled in at least four (4) hours per semester. Some types of assistance, (for example, Pell Grant, Oklahoma’s Promise/OHLAP) must be adjusted if enrollment is less than full-time, even though the educational expense budget remains unchanged. Budgets for students enrolled in fewer hours would include only tuition and fees and books and supplies.
