COLLEGE-WIDE SCHOLARSHIPS

ARLENE STARWALT JESKEY SCHOLARSHIP FUND IN MATH EDUCATION

Recipient must be a full-time sophomore, junior or senior at Oklahoma State University and major in math education or a math major pursuing certification in teacher education. He/she must demonstrate financial need and have a minimum 2.5 GPA with no grade lower than a "C" in any mathematics course. As an incentive to encourage female students to pursue a career in math education, first preference shall be given to female students. The recipient may reapply for scholarship consideration each year.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript and printed statement from Financial Aid. Award amount: \$1000.

BROYLES- WILLARD FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time in the College of Education at OSU, be pursuing a degree in classroom teaching, demonstrate strong leadership abilities and maintain good academic standing established by the OSU. The scholarship may be renewed for up to two years of undergraduate study provided the recipient maintains the established criteria for retention.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$400

COE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Incoming freshman must be planning to enroll as a full-time student in the College of Education, have a 3.0 GPA, and document(s) to indicate how his/her education is being financed.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript and printed statement from Financial Aid. Award amount: \$500

COE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION MINORITY SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate or graduate student must be a full-time student enrolled in an academic degree program in the COE, have a cumulative 3.0 GPA, demonstrate potential for becoming a productive member of the teaching profession through leadership and service, and demonstrate financial need. However, the award will not necessarily go to the student having the greatest financial need.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript and printed statement from Financial Aid. Award Amount: \$500

COE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION UNDERGRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA, be admitted to teacher education, demonstrate outstanding potential for becoming a productive member of the teaching profession through leadership and service, and be a full-time student.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

COE ALUMNI GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be enrolled full-time, maintain a minimum 3.5 GPA, be admitted to a COE graduate program, and demonstrate potential for making outstanding contributions to teaching, research, and outreach.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

COE SPECIAL LEADERSHIP AWARD

Undergraduate or graduate student must have evidence of leadership potential and scholarly achievement, demonstrate a commitment to a career in education, and have a commitment to the development of better understanding the educational needs of all persons. Preference given to minority students.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$400

DANIEL C. AND MARY L. HERD FRESHMAN SCHOLARSHIP

Student must be an incoming freshman, declare and enroll in the College of Education at OSU, be in need of financial assistance, and be chosen through the essay process affiliated with the Celebration of Teaching Event.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION: Completed application form, statement of need from financial aid, and 250 word (or less) essay regarding "Why I would like to become an educator." Award Amount: \$500

EDUCATION STUDENT COUNCIL SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must possess high morals, leadership qualities, and love of education. Criteria are measured by college activities, campus activities, campus honors, and scholarship.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$300

FRANK AND CAROL MORSANI ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE at OSU. Three graduate scholarships will be given per year. One undergraduate scholarship will be given per year.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: 3 (\$1000) for graduate and 1 (\$1000) for undergraduate students.

FUTURE TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP - STATE REGENTS

Undergraduate or graduate student must be in an approved teacher education program and working toward certification in a defined critical shortage teaching field. Students with an earned GPA of 3.0 or higher will be given preference. Incoming freshmen must be graduating or have graduated from an Oklahoma high school, be in the top 15% of their high school class, and score at or above the 85th percentile on the ACT. (Applications available in March or April.)

HELEN M. JONES SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be enrolled in COE. First preference will be given to a student studying curriculum studies. Second preference will be given to a student specializing in the field of secondary education. Financial need will be taken into consideration; however, the award will not necessarily go to the most needy student.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, and printed statement from Financial Aid. Award Amount: 2 for \$1000

HELMER AND FRANCES SORENSON SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be enrolled as a resident graduate student in the COE and be pursuing a doctorate in a discipline associated with school leadership.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$600

INTEL- JOE KITCHENS SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Graduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE and submit a minimum 250 word essay outlining his or her ideas regarding the use of technology in the classroom.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, and essay on technology in the classroom. Award Amount: \$2000

J. ANDREW HOLLEY SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be enrolled in either a master's or doctoral level program in COE and show evidence of high scholarly promise.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

JAMES LEONARD PRINCE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be enrolled in the COE and be admitted to a doctoral program affiliated with an academic department.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$600

JEAN AND HAL LONG ELEMENTARY EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE at OSU. Must be either a junior or senior majoring in elementary education, have earned a minimum 3.0 grade point average, and exhibit financial need and leadership qualities (each will be taken into consideration during the selection process). If the recipient is classified as a junior, he/she may apply to receive the scholarship for an additional year.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$800

JO GRIFFITH HORNER SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE at OSU, have a minimum 2.75 GPA, exhibit strong leadership capabilities, and must be pursuing a degree in secondary education.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$400

JOHN & CAROLINE LINEHAN ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in any discipline within the College of Education at Oklahoma State University. Must be a non-traditional student.

The scholarship may be continued for up to four years provided the student maintains the minimum grade point average—2.5 entering sophomore year; 2.75 entering junior year; 3.0 entering senior year. The recipient will be allowed one probationary semester during the term of the scholarship.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

KENNETH L. AND PEGGY KING SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE at OSU, have earned a minimum 3.5 grade point average and be classified as a sophomore or above. Preference shall be given, but not limited to, a student from a rural high school. Student must not be a recipient of multiple awards.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$400

KNAUB FAMILY ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time junior or senior in the COE and have a minimum 3.0 grade point average. He/she must be majoring in elementary or secondary education with plans to student teach and later teach at the middle school level. Students need to demonstrate leadership ability.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

LOTVEN FAMILY ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP FUND

Graduate student who is enrolled as a full-time student in any discipline in the COE at OSU. The recipient must exhibit financial need and meet minimum standards for teacher certification.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, proof of meeting minimum standards for teacher certification, and printed statement from Financial Aid. Award Amount: \$500

LEW WENTZ SCHOLARSHIP FOR THE ADVANCEMENT OF TEACHING

Undergraduate student currently enrolled as a full-time student at OSU in programs leading toward certification in math, science, and foreign language at the elementary, middle, or secondary level. Scholarships are available to freshmen, sophomores, juniors, and seniors who have declared a major in these areas with a focus on teacher certification and have a minimum grade point average of 3.0. Awards will be made for one year, but students who have received awards may re-apply in subsequent years if satisfactory progress toward certification is evident and all other criteria continue to be met. Please note that all prospective teachers are welcome to apply but first preference will be given to students in math, science and foreign language.

LURA SCHOENLEBER LOOPER MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE at OSU. Preference shall be given to a female junior or senior majoring in elementary education who demonstrates academic achievement and leadership involvement while maintaining a minimum 3.0 grade point average.

May reapply for the scholarship, provided the minimum grade point average is maintained.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

OKLAHOMA STATE TEACHER OF THE YEAR SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled full-time in the COE at OSU and provide evidence of academic achievement and leadership.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

ORA A. HENDERSON SCHOLARSHIP

Available to undergraduate students classified as sophomores, juniors, or seniors who are residents of Oklahoma and who demonstrate academic achievement, leadership qualities, and financial need.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, and printed statement from Financial Aid. Award Amount: 2 for \$500

PATRICIA ZUBER BITTLE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE at OSU. First preference will be given to a non-traditional student pursuing a degree in elementary education.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$1000

RACHEL DOTSON SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be a junior or senior who is preparing for a career in teaching with financial need. Preference will be given to an American Indian who can document that he or she is at least + American Indian descent—should no candidates meet this criteria, it will go to the candidate who has documented the greatest level of American Indian ancestry.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood and printed statement from Financial Aid. Award Amount: \$800

VERA JONES CHAUNCEY SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the COE. First preference shall be given to a female Native American who shows interest, concern, and willingness to serve her community and demonstrates financial need. Financial need may be considered; however, dedication to education has greater merit. The scholarship is a continuing award as long as the recipient is in good standing with the University.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, and Certificate of Degree of Indian Blood. Award Amount: \$500

VIOLA LACHER HOLMES ENDOWED SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student, demonstrate financial need and have an African American or Native American heritage. Native American students must be enrolled in a federally recognized tribe, provide a letter of reference from a tribal government representative in either the executive, legislative or judicial branch of the tribe. Must document evidence of activities reflecting the tribe. First preference shall be given to a female.

WENDELL SHARPTON FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled as an elementary or secondary education major at OSU and be preparing to enter the field of public school teaching, or have a minimum of one year teaching experience. Graduate students must be an Oklahoma resident enrolled in the OSU Graduate College and enrolled in a program for either elementary or secondary education, have a cumulative 3.25 GPA (preferably a graduate from the Charles Page High School in Sand Springs), and demonstrate financial need. However, the award will not necessarily go to the most needy student. EXCLUSION: a student receiving any other endowed scholarship during the same semester shall not be eligible for this scholarship.

AVIATION AND SPACE EDUCATION

ARCHIE TRAMMEL SCHOLARSHIP IN AVIATION

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled full-time in the Aviation and Space Program at Oklahoma State University. First preference shall be given to a female student; must have earned at least a Private Pilot Certification, have superior potential as a professional in aviation, be of good character, and have above average academic credentials.

CHRISTIENSEN AVIATION SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student in the Aviation Program at Oklahoma State University-Stillwater or OSU-Tulsa. He/she must be pursuing a bachelor's degree as a professional pilot, have at least a 2.75 grade point average and be classified at any undergraduate level. Scholarship may be received for multiple years, subject to annual review by the scholarship selection committee.

GRETCHEN LYNNETTE CUMBERLEDGE MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Preference will be given to female students. Applicant may be a non-aviation major. Applicants will be judged on aviation and extracurricular activities.

HOYT E. WALKUP SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must have a 2.5 cumulative GPA or higher (attach copy of transcript), be a member in good standing of the OSU Flying Aggies, possess a Private Pilot Certificate, and be enrolled or plan to enroll in a credit class toward a higher rating (commercial, instrument, CFI, etc.) at OSU through Aviation Education. The student must not have received previous financial assistance from an OSU AVSED scholarship for the year. The student must demonstrate financial need, be attending OSU during the fall semester, and possess diligent work habits and a genuine interest in aviation.

Graduate or undergraduate student must be a junior, senior, or graduate elementary education major planning to teach in the primary grades, have a desire to emphasize reading, and demonstrate financial need.

DANIEL AND MARY HERD MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must have a 2.5 GPA, be a full-time student in elementary education who plans to teach at the elementary level, be in need of financial assistance, and possess high morals and leadership qualities.

J. KENNETH ST. CLAIR SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be enrolled full-time in the School of Curriculum and Educational Leadership or School of Educational Studies and pursuing an advanced degree in educational administration with the intent of serving as an administrator in schools grades K-12. Consideration should be given to professional experiences, commitment to academic excellence and organizational leadership abilities.

LEON L. MUNSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student (senior) or graduate student must be seeking credentials to teach English at the secondary level, be qualified to student teach, demonstrate a strong commitment to teach English at the secondary level, and be a well-rounded individual with a pleasing personality and a sense of humor. The scholarship will be given to a student who is planning to teach during the spring semester.

MABLE MARIETTA MACEY OAKS MEMORIAL ART SCHOLARSHIP

Undergraduate student must be an art education student in the COE at OSU with a grade point average of 2.50 overall and 3.0 in the area of art specialization. The student must be in the final semester of his/her program, be seriously interested in pursuing a career in art education, and present documentation of teaching experience (volunteer or paid), preferably in art (church, YMCA, community) other than student teaching and program related experience.

Selection committee will interview applicants. Award Amount: \$500

Graduate student must have an overall grade point average of 3.0. Must be pursuing an advanced degree with an emphasis in art education, be enrolled in the Graduate College at OSU, be in the final semester of an approved graduate program, and have successfully completed the written and oral examinations. The money is to be used for typing, printing, and binding of dissertation or thesis or other expenses related to completion of the dissertation or thesis.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, printed statement from Financial Aid, letter of reference from employer (preferably from your teaching experiences), and supporting documentation/evidence of art teaching and accomplishments. Selection committee will interview the scholarship applicants. Award Amount: \$800 (master's candidate) and \$1000 (doctoral candidate)

RAY E. BROWN MEMORIAL

Undergraduate or graduate student must be enrolled as a full-time student. First preference shall be given to a student majoring in technology education. May be an incoming freshman. Must display high academic achievement and outstanding leadership ability during high school. Must demonstrate financial need.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, and a printed statement from Financial Aid. Award Amount: 2 for \$500

RICHARD AND EDNA JUNGERS

Graduate student must be a full-time student in higher education administration, have a minimum 3.25 GPA, and exhibit financial need. First preference given to students pursuing a career in school administration (including superintendents, principals). Second preference given to students pursuing a career in higher education administration.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form, current transcript, and a printed statement from financial aid. Award Amount: \$500

EDUCATIONAL STUDIES

J. KENNETH ST. CLAIR SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be enrolled full-time in the School of Curriculum and Educational Leadership or School of Educational Studies pursuing an advanced degree in Educational Administration with the intent of serving as an administrator in schools grades K-12. Consideration should be given to professional experiences, commitment to academic excellence, and organizational leadership abilities.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

LLOYD L. WIGGINS SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be a full-time student majoring in occupational and adult education, including vocational education and adult continuing education. First preference will be given to students preparing for leadership positions in state agencies. Other candidates may be nominated.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

LOCKE, WRIGHT, FOSTER, AND CROSS GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be a doctoral student in educational administration who demonstrates high academic achievement. First preference given to candidates most recently employed within Oklahoma.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript. Award Amount: \$500

RICHARD AND EDNA JUNGERS SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must be a full-time student in higher education administration, have a minimum 3.25 GPA, and exhibit financial need. First preference given to students pursuing a career in school administration (including superintendents, principals). Second preference given to students pursuing a career in higher education administration.

SUPPORTING DOCUMENTATION NEEDED: Completed application form and current transcript and a printed statement from financial aid. Award Amount: \$500

RICHARD MOSIER LEADERSHIP IN HIGHER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP

Graduate student must have completed at least 9 hours toward an advanced degree in higher education administration while maintaining a 3.5 GPA. Applicants must submit strong letters of recommendation from faculty members with whom they have worked and must also be enrolled in at least 6 hours per semester at OSU to be eligible for the scholarship.

ROBERT B. AND MAXINE KAMM DISTINGUISHED GRADUATE FELLOWSHIP

Graduate student must be a post-baccalaureate student who displayed both high academic achievement and outstanding leadership during his/her undergraduate and graduate education. He/she must be committed to students and positively impact their lives on campus, be enrolled as a full-time graduate student, and be selected from candidates pursuing advanced degrees in higher education administration in the School of Educational Studies.
