## 2008-2009 IMPORTANT INFORMATION SHEET TRANSFER UNIVERSITY AWARD

Congratulations on being awarded an Oklahoma State University tuition scholarship. The following information is very important to you as a recipient of this award. Please retain this sheet and copies of the award materials for your files.

This undergraduate tuition scholarship may be used for fall and spring semesters only and is an automatic reduction from the tuition portion (resident or nonresident, depending on your award) of your OSU Bursar charges each semester. You must pay all other fees. This scholarship pays for **resident courses only**; it does not pay for Internet courses or 600-series section courses. Up to one-half of your total annual award (depending on the number of hours you take) will be subtracted directly from your Bursar bill each fall and spring. **Tuition scholarships cannot be used in summer or intersessions.**

You must be classified as an **undergraduate student** to be paid this tuition scholarship. If you attend OSU only one fall or spring semester in any year of eligibility, you will receive no more than one-half of your scholarship's value that year. You must enroll in a minimum of **12 credit hours per semester** to receive this tuition scholarship. You are eligible for only **one tuition waiver scholarship** per semester. You may also accept scholarships from other OSU departments (as long as they are not tuition waiver scholarships) as well as scholarships from outside organizations.

If your academic record and/or admission test scores (as appropriate) improve after the February 1, 2008 priority deadline (October 15, 2008 for spring 2009 entering students), you will be considered for an upgrade to a higher value award only **if funds remain available**. You should send copies of new scores and/or transcripts to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions **as soon as possible** so your eligibility for a higher value award can be reassessed, but OSU reserves the right to stop making new or higher value awards **at any time**.

If, between now and the beginning of school, your admission status changes because of new information or performance, OSU reserves the right to retract this scholarship as only fully admissible students in good academic standing are eligible to receive these benefits. This tuition scholarship cannot be used for graduate or professional school.

Your award is a **one-year award** that is not renewable. **Once you are attending OSU full time**, you are encouraged to submit the online Scholarship Application for Continuing and Readmitted Undergraduates each year. The application will be available on our web site at <http://www.okstate.edu/finaid> no later than December 1 each year and must be submitted no later than the following **February 1**. Awards from this application are competitive and made on the basis of several factors including cumulative graduation/retention GPA, hours earned, financial need, resident vs. nonresident status, academic major, whether the application was submitted by the February 1 deadline, etc. Award amounts are determined by budgetary realities at the time and the number of applicants. Continuing student tuition waivers have usually been lower in value than the one-year or multi-year waivers for new students.
